1. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

2. Generic

5. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

1)Technical competency:

A.TECHNICAL:

1) Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) are eligible to participate in the tender. They shall furnish document &self-declaration certificate to prove that they are the manufactures of similar item.

AND

2) OEM should have supplied at least one no. of similar item of 5TPH capacity to any Mineral sands industry in OEM's name or authorised agent's/authorised bidders name during last seven years ending April 2024.

In proof of the above, the following documents are to be submitted along with offer.

- a) Purchase order copy of similar supply in the name of OEM or authorised bidder or any other authorised bidder of OEM.
- b) Satisfactory performance certificate / work completion certificate from the client.

Definition of similar supply/item: Hydrosizer (Hydro classifier) of capacity 5TPH or above.

NB: For MSE & Start-Up Bidders Past experience is relaxed. However, bidders have to establish their technical competency by submitting supporting documents towards successful execution of similar work **for any Capacity**, failure to which the offer will not be considered for evaluation.

2) Note: As per para 7.3.5 on (Clarification of Bids/Shortfall Documents) of the Manual for Procurement of Goods 2017, issued by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, During evaluation and comparison of bids, the purchaser may, at his discretion, ask the bidder for clarifications on the bid. The request for clarification shall be given asking the tenderer to respond by a specified date. If the tenderer does not comply or respond by the date, his tender will be liable to be rejected. Depending on the outcome, such tenders are to be ignored or considered further. No change in prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted. No post bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained. **The shortfall information / documents should be sought only in case of historical documents which pre-existed at the time of the tender opening and which have not undergone change since then.** So far as the submission of documents is concerned with regard to qualification criteria, after submission of the tender, only related shortfall documents should be asked for and considered. **For example, if the bidder has submitted a supply order without its completion / performance certificate, the certificate can be asked for and considered. 12. SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF WORK/CONTRACT

SCOPE OF WORK/CONTRACT

a. Design, engineering, manufacture and supply of 5TPH Hydrosizer as per detailed specification, terms and conditions provided in the tender

b. Required transportation of items from contractor's works to IREL's stores shall be arranged by Supplier at their cost and risk.

c. Unloading of equipment shall be done by IREL at OSCOM stores

d. Erection of equipment shall be done by IREL. The contractor shall provide required supervisory support for commissioning of the system at our site.

e. Contractor shall demonstrate the performance of the system as per requirement of the tender.

TRAINING

The contractor shall provide necessary training to IREL staff for operation and maintenance of the system. They shall also provide the Operations and Maintenance Manuals, catalogues, etc for the entire system, including brought out major components.

TIME PERIOD OF COMPLETION:

a.The item shall be supplied to OSCOM within **3 months** of acceptance of GA drawing. GA drawing shall be submitted within 7 days of receipt of Purchase Order.

b.The successful bidder shall extend necessary support for erection and commissioning of the system as required by IREL.

c.IREL shall erect the machine **within 2 months** from the date of supply of item at its stores. Commissioning and performance run shall be satisfactorily completed within a total span of **5 months** from the date of placement of order.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

70% payment along with 100% taxes and duties shall be made against tax invoice within 30 days of receipt & acceptance of the equipment at IREL.

Balance 30% shall be paid after successful commissioning of the equipment or 06 months from date of supply whichever is earlier.

PACKAGING SITE HANDLING, STORAGE OF MATERIALS & EQUIPMENTS:

The equipment, material etc. shall be so packed and protected so as not to suffer any deterioration, damage or breakage during shipment, handling and storage in a tropical climate, ideally in wooden cartons. All exposed ferrous metal surfaces shall be covered with a suitable rust preventive compound of reputed make. Large items shall be individually crated

MARKING ON PACKAGES:

Each package will be marked on three sides with proper paint/indelible ink, the following (1) Purchaser Name & Address (2) Item Nomenclature (3) Order/Contract No. (4) Packing list reference number.

INSURANCE: The Goods supplied under the Contract shall be fully insured in Indian Rupees against loss or damage during transportation/shipment and handling. For delivery of goods to the purchaser's premises, it is advised that **transit insurance** shall be obtained by the Supplier for an amount equal to 110% of the value of the goods from "Warehouse to warehouse" (final destinations) on "All Risks" basis including War Risks and Strikes.

The contractor shall take **workmen compensation policy** with sickness benefit to cover liability for workmen employed by the contractor as per Employee compensation Act and shall produce the same before commencement of the work.

TRANSPORTATION:

Delivery of the equipment/materials to IREL, (India) Ltd, OSCOM shall be done by the contractor at their risk and cost.

UNLOADING, HANDLING: Unloading at site shall be done by **IREL**. Procedure for unloading and handling shall be communicated by the supplier to IREL.

INSPECTION: The items will be inspected by IREL on receipt at IREL site. You may at your option depute your representative for carrying out joint inspection at site or else IREL may conduct inspection on its own. If it is found that any item does not conform to the specification given, or is defective in any manner, the same will be rejected and supplier should arrange for immediate replacement thereof, free of cost to us inclusive of all taxes and duties. Such replacement supplies will also be subjected to our inspection as above before acceptance. However, such supplies, if delayed beyond the period of contract will be considered as late supply and will attract Liquidated damages.

ERECTION:

Erection of equipment shall be **done by IREL at its cost and risk**. The successful bidder shall

provide required guidance for proper erection of the equipment.

TESTING AND COMMISSIONING:

After installation the system, it shall be tested to ensure that the system is capable of delivering the required performance.

The successful bidder shall provide required **supervisory supports for trial run** and commissioning of the equipment.

FINAL ACCEPTANCE CERTIFICATE (FAC):

The FAC will be issued by the PURCHASER only on demonstration of the technical specifications /performance. The warranty shall commence only from the date of the issuance of the FAC.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED:

The following documents (in English) shall be provided along with the Unit in both hardcopy and softcopy forms:

- a. Unloading and Handling procedures.
- b. Operation and maintenance manuals
- c. troubleshooting procedures
- d. Wiring and other schematic diagrams
- e. List of components, spares and accessories.
- f. If there are any bought-out systems and components, manuals of these are desirable to be provided in hard/softcopy.
- g. Safety and security instruction manual should be provided.
- h. Warrantee certificates as applicable

WARRANTEE:

The materials/equipments and all accessories supplied shall be warranted against any defective material, malfunctioning or poor workmanship for a minimum period of **12 months from the date of installation and commissioning as indicated in FAC or 18 months from the date of supply, whichever is earlier.**

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR DELAY IN EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

For delays attributable to the contractor, liquidated damages shall be levied at the rate of **@ 0.5% per week or part thereof on the total value of the contract subject to a maximum of 10% of the total value of the contract.(for calculation of LD, the delivery for effecting complete supply of items to IREL's stores only will be considered)**The liquidated damage will be recovered from any outstanding bills or amount due to the successful bidder.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

a) WORK AND SUPPLY INCIDENTAL

- i) The equipment/components supplied shall have high degree of reliability, the supplier shall offer & supply equipment/components of proven design, excellent workmanship and proven industrial running record. All materials supplied by the contractor shall be of good quality conforming to relevant and applicable standards for use in India and shall be suitable for the service specified.
- ii) The contractor shall include all other equipment /components/ instruments etc. which are not described herein specifically but are deemed necessary for completeness, safety and satisfactory performance of the supply under their scope.
- iii) If any work and supplies this is not included in the scope of work/supplies but required for completion of the work, shall be provided by the contractor

b) REGULATIONS, ACTS, STANDARDS & CODES TO BE FOLLOWED:

The design, manufacture and testing of the equipment covered in this specification shall comply with the appropriate standards amended to date. Unless otherwise specified, Indian Standards shall be followed. In case where suitable Indian Standards are not available, generally accepted codes and practices as mutually agreed upon shall be adopted. The equipments shall comply with the statutory requirements of the Govt. of India. The equipment and installation shall conform to the provision of statutory and other regulations in force such Indian Electricity Act etc.

The successful bidder shall provide the necessary support like drawings, data etc as required by the statutory authorities. In cases where the offer deviates from the specified standards, the successful bidder shall indicate clearly in his offer the standards proposed to be adopted by him and the details thereof.

c) **BATTERY LIMITS**

a) **What IREL shall provide :**

- i. Feeding and discharging arrangements to the hydrosizer shall be arranged by IREL at its cost. Necessary details to be provided by the contractor/supplier to IREL well in advance
- ii. Required minor structural works for installation of the machines shall be provided by IREL at its cost. Required drawings along with technical details may be provided by the contractor.
- iii. Unloading of item at IREL's stores shall be done by IREL at its risk and cost
- iv. Necessary mobilisation of items to installation site shall be provided by IREL at its risk and cost
- v. Required electrical connection to the machines shall be provided by IREL at its cost
- vi. Installation shall be done by IREL as per the supplier's guidelines.
- vii. Required feed for testing the machines for performance run will be provided by IREL
- viii. Required tools and tackles other than specialised ones for the work
- ix. Required consumables shall be provided by IREL

b) **What Contractor/supplier shall provide** In addition to what is spelt out already in the contract,

- i. Required guidelines for unloading, handling and erection in a safe and proper manner
- ii. Required skilled supervision during trial run and commissioning.

d) **TIMING OF WORK**

- i. The site works at IREL shall be carried out between 9 AM to 5 PM. Extension may be allowed under specific approval from IREL
- ii. Work will normally be allowed on all days excluding Holidays and Sundays. On specific request, IREL may allow work to be carried out on Sunday and Holidays also. But the right for such grant rests solely with IREL.

e) **TOOLS AND TACKLES**

- i. **IREL** shall provide the required tools and tackles and consumables required for the erection work.
- ii. Contractor shall also supply specialized Tools and Tackles required for operation and maintenance of the system supplied by them.
- iii. All the tools and tackles/measuring instruments shall be duly tested/calibrated and valid certificate to that effect should be maintained

f) **COOPERATING WITH IREL /OTHER CONTRACTORS**

The contractor shall co-operate with IREL and other contractors working in site and arrange to per

form his work in a manner so as to minimize interference with other contractor's works

G) WORKMANSHIP

Every effort shall be made to maintain the highest quality of workmanship by stringent supervision and inspection at every stage of execution. Manufacturer's instruction manual and guidelines on sequence of erection and precautions shall be strictly followed.

H) CONSUMABLES

All the required consumables like Oxygen / Acetylene / argon /Nitrogen/Welding electrodes, etc required for site work at **IREL shall be arranged by IREL at its cost**. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to plan the activities and intimate IREL to stock sufficient quantity of these items. Non-availability of them cannot be considered as reason for not attaining the required progress.

i) MANPOWER

- i. **Contractor has to deploy skilled and experienced technicians required for supervising smooth and safe trial and commissioning run.** They shall wear required PPEs
- ii. The rates quoted by contractor shall cover the to & fro travelling expenses of personnel engaged by them for the work, their boarding, lodging expenses, etc.

j) SECURITY

- i. The contractor shall while carrying out work at IREL shall follow all safety and security regulations and practices followed at IREL.
- ii. All persons engaged at IREL should have obtained security clearance and safety briefing
- iii. All material moved in and out of IREL shall be with due approval from Engineer In Charge and after making necessary recordings at security gates.

k) SAFETY

All persons engaged at IREL should have undergone safety training/safety briefing from our safety department prior to their engagement in IREL

i The contractor shall provide all personal protective equipment viz. Helmet, Safety shoe, etc., to the workmen engaged for the work.

ii.All the rules regarding the Authorization / permit / clearance system shall be fully adhered to.

l) ACCIDENT OR INJURY TO WORKMEN

- i. The safety and welfare of workmen engaged by the contractor (successful bidder) at site shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor and the workmen shall abide by the rules & regulations set by the company.
- ii. IREL shall not be liable for or in respect of any damages or compensation payable as per or otherwise in respect of or in consequence of any accident or injury to any workmen or other persons in the employment/engagement of the Contractor or any Sub-Contractor and the Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Employer against all such damages and compensation and against all claims, demands, proceedings, cost, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof in relation thereto.
- iii. IREL will not provide any insurance or medical facility to the staff of contractor or persons engaged by him for execution of the contract. The responsibility lies solely with the contractor
- iv. The Contractor shall forthwith report all accidents and injuries as a result of his contractual work to IREL.

m) RULES AND REGULATIONS

- i. The contractor shall comply with all the rules and regulations of the local authorities, all statutory laws including Minimum Wages, Workmen Compensation etc. All registration and statutory inspection fees, if any, in respect of the work executed by the contractor shall be to his account.
- ii. The rules and regulations existing in the company and practiced for similar works will be also applicable to this contract.

n) CARE OF MATERIAL ETC ISSUED TO THE CONTRACTOR

i. The contractor shall solely be responsible for the safety & quality of material, if any, handed over and issued to contractor by IREL

ii. The contractor will take necessary precautions/ due care to protect the material at Project site, while in his custody from any damage/ loss till the same is handed over to IREL at Project site.

O) INSPECTION OF MATERIAL/WORKS

i. All materials brought by the contractor shall be as per the tender specification and if not clearly spelt, shall conform to relevant latest IS standards/sound industry practice

ii. IREL shall have full authority to inspect the works at any time whenever in progress either on the site or at contractors works wherever situated.

p) WORK COMPLETION AND COMMISSIONING TEST

i. On completion of the installation, the IREL shall notify contractor for its readiness for carrying out the commissioning test.

ii. Commissioning test shall be done at a mutually convenient date/s and time

iii. The commissioning test of the system shall be done for duration of 4 hours at a stretch. During the period, the system shall be tested to a capacity of 80% or above of the rated capacity and the deliverables are monitored to see that it conforms to the tender stipulation.

iv. The work under the scope of the contractor shall be deemed to have been completed in all respects only when so certified by IREL. The decision of IREL in this regard shall be final and binding on the contractor.
