While delivering Caustic Soda Lye one sealed sample bottle of the product loaded i nto the tanker should be handed over to the transporter for handing over to the consignee along with the supply. In the event of manufacturer not giving the sample bottle, an endorsement on the Delivery Challan to this effect 'sample not provided "should be done before the tankers leave the loading sight. After the safe arrival of the tanker at IREL Stores, Caustic Soda Lye in the tanker will be analysed at IREL lab. if on analysis it is noticed that the concentration is less than the specified concentration in your Challan, then the sealed sample will be opened for analysis and verification.

Rejected Stores: Rejected stores will remain at destination at the Supplier's risk an d responsibility and to be immediately replaced with stores of specified quality tow ards acceptance.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
