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- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service

provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the OM_No.1_4_2021_PPD_dated_18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated online in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

4. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The tenderer should be submit the following towards Pre-Qualification Criteria:

- Bidder should be OEM i.e M/s OLM Systems & Technologies, Noida (or) their Authorized Dealer

 Bidder shall attach / submit an Authorized Dealer / Authorized Distributor Certificate issued b
 y OEM.
- 2. Financial: Average annual financial turnover of the bidder during last 3 years ending 31/03/20 23 should be of minimum ₹86,730/-. Copy of Profit & Loss account and Balance Sheet for the years 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 has to be submitted. Documentary evidence towards the same has to be submitted.

Note:

- 1. In the absence of receipt of documents meeting to Pre-qualification criteria, the offer will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 2. Relaxation in prior turnover and prior experience shall be given to MSEs / Startups (as defined by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) as per Government Circular / Guidelines su bject to meeting of quality and technical Specification.
- 3. Traders/ distributors/ sole agent/ Works Contract are excluded from the purview of the Procur ement Policy for Micro and small Enterprises, 2012 (as amended time to time).
- 4. The offers of the bidders who have defaulted in the past in execution of the contracts or in complying with the obligations as per the contract shall not be considered.

5.-Concurrent commitment:

The bidder has to submit complete list of concurrent commitments on all jobs under execution by them, as per format given below, which will be taken into account to assess the spare capa city available with the bidder. If the annualized concurrent commitments of the bidder plus an nualized estimated value of the work exceeds four times the average annual financial turnove r during the last three financial years of the bidder, then the bid of such a bidder shall not be considered for further evaluation.

Concurrent commitment of the bidder shall be evaluated as on the last day of the Month previous to bid due date, based on the confirmation/declaration of the bidders that they have disclosed all works being executed by them. Bidders shall exclude all stalled project for which there is no progress in last one year giving reason for no progress considering above cut-off date. In case any adverse report/complaint are received against bidder and on enquiry found correct, of fer shall be rejected and bidder shall be liable for appropriate legal action.

OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **1.0** Bidders have to upload the following along with the Bid
 - (i) Documents towards pre qualification of tender failing which offer shall not be accepted.
 - (ii) Copy of GST, PAN, MSME Registration
 - (iii)—EMD Declaration
 - (iv) Undertaking provided in tender, duly filled and signed
 - (v) Contact details with e-mail, Phone no. etc.

2.0—Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- 2.1—Tenderer shall remit EMD through RTGS/ NEFT infavour of M/s IREL (India) Limited, Manavala-kurichi.
- 2.2—Tenderer shall inform details of remittance of EMD & TDC through E-Mail/ FAX. The E-mail should contain full postal address of the Tenderer, Tender No. for which EMD & TDC were paid, payment details including amount, and UTR No. and bank details from which payment was done. IREL's Email id is purchase-mk@irel.co.in
- 2.3—Incase tenderer is submitting BG in lieu of EMD the same shall be strictly in the format given in the tender. The Original BG shall reach this office at least 3 days in advance from the date of opening of Techno-Commercial Bid.
- 2.4—Offers without EMD or valid EMD exemption certificate shall not be considered.
- 2.5—The EMD is liable to be forfeited if:

	—the tenderer changes the terms and conditions or prices or withdraw his quotation subsequent to the date of opening.
ii.	—The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence supplies/work s after accepting the order.
iii. -	—In case bidder submits false/fabricated documents.
—— i∨. -	In case bidder fails to submit SD within 30 days of receipt of work/supply order.

2.6—PSU, State Govt. Undertakings are exempted from payment of EMD subject to request and a pproval. MSME /SSI units—are exempted from payment of EMD/ TDC provided they submit valid MSME/NSIC certificate along with commercial bid and to ensure that certificate pertains to the class of item/works for which floated.

3.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD),

- 3.1 Security deposit (SD) shall be uniformly levied @ 5% of contract value (excluding Taxes) tow ards satisfactory completion of the order/works as under:
 - a. For works contract valued more than Rs.2 lakhs.
 - b. For supply & service contract valued more than Rs.5 lakhs.

 Performance Security is to be furnished by a specified date (generally 14 (fourteen) days after notification of the award) and it should remain valid for a period of 60 (sixty) days b eyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier/ contractor, including warranty obligations/ defect liability period (DLP).
- 3.2 Submission of SD/PBG, if called for in the tender can also be paid through Insurance Surety B onds' or 'account payee demand draft' or 'fixed deposit receipt from a Scheduled Commercia I bank' or 'Bank Guarantee issued/ confirmed from any Scheduled Commercial Banks in India ' or online payment to be confirmed sharing Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) to the tend er inviting authority as called for in tender.
- 3.3 Bank Guarantees towards Bid Security/ Security Deposit/ PBG issued by Nationalized Banks/ Scheduled Commercial Banks (other than Cooperative Banks) only acceptable.
- 3.4 EMD/ Bid Security may be adjusted towards SD. However, if EMD is submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee, fresh Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format or demand draft/Bankers ch eque is to be submitted towards SD.
- 3.5 The SD shall not bear any interest and is liable to be forfeited for unsatisfactory completion or on abandonment of the supply/ work order.

4.0 Payment Terms

- 4.1 Payment will be made within 30 days after completion of each service visit and submission of bill, on pro-rata basis.
- 4.2 Payment for the spares replaced during the service shall be released at the rates of price list submitted by the party.
- 4.3 All payments will be done only through E payment. Hence the contractor has to provide the complete bank details along with GST registration details.
- 4.4 All payments are subject to deduction of tax at source as applicable.
- 4.5 GST Law mandates Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) vide Section 51 of the CGST/SGST Act 20 17, Section 20 of the IGST Act, 2017and Section 21 of the UTGST Act, 2017.
- 4.6 Our GSTIN33AAACI2799F1ZL and SAC code of service is to be mentioned in the bills.
- 4.7 All payment will be done only through e-payment. Hence the contractor has to provide their name, Account number, Name of the bank, nature of account (Savings/Current/CC/OD), IFSC, Branch code and cancelled cheque along with invoice.

5.0 LIQUIDATED DAMGES FOR DELAYED EXECUTION OF CONTRACT:

If the Service Provider fails to perform the services within the time period(s)specified in the C ONTRACT, the EMPLOYER shall, without prejudice to his other remedies under the CONTRACT, levy Liquidated damages from the CONTRACT PRICE, a sum calculated on the basis of the C ONTRACT PRICE, including subsequent modifications.

Deductions shall apply as per following formula:

Half percent (0.5%) of the contract value per week of delay subject to a maximum of ten per cent (10%) of contract value

EMPLOYER may deduct the amount so payable by Service Provider, from any amount falling due to the Service Provider or by recovery against the Performance Guarantee. Both Service Provider and EMPLOYER agree that the above percentages of price reduction are genuine pre-estimates of the loss/damage which the EMPLOYER would have suffered on account of delay /breach on the part of the Service Provider and the said amount will be payable on demand without there being any proof of the actual loss/or damage caused by such breach/delay. A d ecision of the EMPLOYER in the matter of applicability of price reduction shall be final and bin ding.

6.0 Period of contract

The period of contract will be for 1year. Total no. of service visits during the period of contract will be 4 (four).

7.0 Penalty:

The party has to attend the work as per schedule. The breakdown calls are to be attended wi thin 72 hours of intimation. If not attended & rectified, even after 72 hours, a penalty of Rs. 1000/- will be charged for each day of delay.

- **6.0** In case of any discrepancy between Gem ATC and Buyer ATC, terms stipulated in Buyer ATC shall govern.
- **7.0** In case of any discrepancy between GeM SLA terms and ATC stipulated by IREL, Terms stipulated by IREL shall govern.
- 8.0 MSE bidders are to carefully indicate their MSE status while bidding. In case any mistake done by the bidder, evaluation and order shall be done as per GeM provisions only and IREL (India) Limited shall not be anyway held responsible.

If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.

- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

This Bid is governed by the <u>General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्त</u>, conditions stipulated in Bid and <u>Service Level Agreement</u> specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्ते is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
