1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.

2. 4. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents. 6. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference for service provider quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents. 6. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

8. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or

#### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

#### **PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA**

#### The bidder should submit the following towards pre-qualification criteria.

- 1. The tenderer should have a valid Customs Broker License and able to transact business as Custom Broker at Tuticorin port till the date of completion as specified in the tender.
- 2. The tenderer must have experience in successful completion of similar works duri ng the last seven years ending 31.12.2023 and the same should be either of the f ollowing
  - 1) 3 similar works costing Rs.31,71,618.28/- each (OR)
  - 2) 2 similar works costing Rs.39,64,522.85/-each (OR)
  - 3) 1 similar work costing Rs.63,43,236.56/-

- **1.0** The rate quoted shall be FOR IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi. The items have to be supplied strictly as per the technical specification within the delivery period mentioned in the tender.

### 2.0 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- **2.1** Rs.1,34,391/- (Rupees One lakh thirty four thousand three hundred and ninety one only)
- **2.2** Tenderer shall remit EMD through RTGS/ NEFT infavour of M/s IREL (India) Limit ed, Manavalakurichi.
- **2.3** Tenderer shall inform details of remittance of EMD & TDC through E-Mail/ FAX. The E-mail should contain full postal address of the Tenderer, Tender No. for whi ch EMD & TDC were paid, payment details including amount, and UTR No. and b ank details from which payment was done. - **2.4** Incase tenderer is submitting BG in lieu of EMD the same shall be strictly in the format given in the tender. The Original BG shall reach this office at least 3 days in advance from the date of opening of Techno-Commercial Bid.
- 2.5 Offers without EMD or valid EMD exemption certificate shall not be considered.2.6 The EMD is liable to be forfeited if:
  - i. The tenderer changes the terms and conditions or prices or withdraw his q uotation subsequent to the date of opening.
  - ii. The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence s upplies/works after accepting the order.
  - iii. In case bidder submits false/fabricated documents.
  - iv. In case bidder fails to submit SD within 30 days of receipt of work/supply or der.

2.7 PSU, State Govt. Undertakings are exempted from payment of EMD subject to r equest and approval. MSME /SSI units are exempted from payment of EMD/ T DC provided they submit valid MSME/ NSIC certificate along with commercial bi d and to ensure that certificate pertains to the class of item/works for which floa ted.

# 3.0 Security Deposit (SD),

**3.1** Security deposit (SD) shall be uniformly levied @ 5% of contract value (excluding Taxes) towards s atisfactory completion of the order/works as under:

a. For works contract valued more than Rs.2 lakhs.

b. For supply & service contract valued more than Rs.5 lakhs.

Performance Security is to be furnished by a specified date (generally 14 (fourte en) days after notification of the award) and it should remain valid for a period o f 60 (sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of t he supplier/ contractor, including warranty obligations/ defect liability period (DL P).

- 3.2 Submission of SD/PBG, if called for in the tender can also be paid through Insura nce Surety Bonds' or 'account payee demand draft' or 'fixed deposit receipt fro m a Scheduled Commercial bank' or 'Bank Guarantee issued/ confirmed from an y Scheduled Commercial Banks in India' or online payment to be confirmed shar ing Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) to the tender inviting authority as calle d for in tender.
- 3.3 Bank Guarantees towards Bid Security/ Security Deposit/ PBG issued by Nation alized Banks/ Scheduled Commercial Banks (other than Cooperative Banks) only acceptable.
- 3.4 EMD/ Bid Security may be adjusted towards SD. However, if EMD is submitted in the form of Bank Gu arantee, fresh Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format or demand draft/Bankers cheque is to be su bmitted towards SD.
- 3.5 The SD shall not bear any interest and is liable to be forfeited for unsatisfactory completion or on ab andonment of the supply/ work order.

# 4.0 Payment Terms

Payment will be released after completion of each shipment of export. In case shipment is delayed b y more than 15 days after completion of transportation of entire material for the shipping at a time, 60% of the rate quoted against item no.1 will be released. The contractor shall not be entitled to clai m any payment for non-shipment / short shipment or for salient cargo or delay in shipment if the sp ace is reserved by buyers or IREL. It shall be the duty of the contractor to effect shipment expeditio usly. All payments to the contractor will be subject to deduction of Income Tax at source as provided in Section 194 (c) of the Income Tax Act. 1961 & other applicable deductions. Payment for items No. C to K in price schedule will be done as & when required. Payment will be carried out as per actual within 30 days.

All payments are subject to deduction of tax at source as applicable.

GST Law mandates Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) vide section 51 of the CGST/ SGST act 2017, section 20 of the IGST act 2017 and section 21 of the UTGST act 2017.

Our GSTIN 33AAACI2799F1ZL and SAC code of service is to be mentioned in the bills.

All the payment will be done only through e-payment. Hence, you have to provi de your name, account no., name of the bank, and nature of account (savings/cu rrent/CC/OD), IFSC, branch code and cancelled check along with invoice.

# **5.0 Liquidated Damages for Delayed Execution of Contract:**

If the Service Provider fails to perform the services within the time period(s) sp ecified in the CONTRACT, the EMPLOYER shall, without prejudice to his other re medies under the CONTRACT, levy Liquidated damages from the CONTRACT P RICE, a sum calculated on the basis of the CONTRACT PRICE, including subseq uent modifications.

## Deductions shall apply as per following formula:

Half percent (0.5%) of the contract value per week of delay subject to a maximu m of ten percent (10%) of contract value.

EMPLOYER may deduct the amount so payable by Service Provider, from any am ount falling due to the Service Provider or by recovery against the Performance Guarantee. Both Service Provider and EMPLOYER agree that the above percenta ges of price reduction are genuine pre-estimates of the loss/damage which the E MPLOYER would have suffered on account of delay/breach on the part of the Ser vice Provider and the said amount will be payable on demand without there bein g any proof of the actual loss/or damage caused by such breach/delay. A decisio n of the EMPLOYER in the matter of applicability of price reduction shall be final and binding.

- **7.0 Period of Contract:** The period of contract is one year from the date of start o f work. If the entire quantity could not be transported within one year from the d ate of start of work due to reasons attributed to IREL, the period of contact can be further extended for a maximum period of another six months for the balanc e quantity, if any on mutually agreeable basis of IREL and the successful bidder. The work is to be started within 3 days from the date of intimation received fro m IREL. It is open to IREL to terminate the contract without assigning any reason or reasons by giving two weeks notice and no claim for any loss or damage or co mpensation for such terminations of contract shall be payable by IREL or mainta inable against IREL.
- **8.0** In case of any discrepancy between Gem ATC and Buyer ATC, terms stipulated i n Buyer ATC shall govern.
- **9.0** In case of any discrepancy between GeM SLA terms and ATC stipulated by IREL, Terms stipulated by IREL shall govern.

# 10.0 MSE bidders are to carefully indicate their MSE status while bidding. In case any mistake done by the bidder, evaluation and order shall be don e as per GeM provisions only and IREL (India) Limited shall not be anyw ay held responsible.

If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
