- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. - 6. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

7. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 50% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

#### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

#### 2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

#### **PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA**

The tenderer should submit the following towards Pre- Qualification Criteria:

- 1. Only Allen Cooper/Liberty/Bata/ JAMA/Hillson make shall be acceptable.
- 2. Bidder shall be the original manufacturer or authorized dealer for Allen Cooper /Li berty/Bata/ JAMA/Hillson.
- 3. Authorized dealer shall submit their valid dealership certificate/ authorization lett er from OEM.

- 2.5—The EMD is liable to be forfeited if:

- ————ii.—The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence s upplies/works after accepting the order.

### 3.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD),

- 3.1 Security deposit (SD) shall be uniformly levied @ 5% of contract value (excluding Taxes) towards s atisfactory completion of the order/works as under:
  - a. For works contract valued more than Rs.2 lakhs.
  - b. For supply & service contract valued more than Rs.5 lakhs.
    - Performance Security is to be furnished by a specified date (generally 14 (fou rteen) days after notification of the award) and it should remain valid for a pe riod of 60 (sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligat ions of the supplier/ contractor, including warranty obligations/ defect liability period (DLP).
- 3.2 Submission of SD/PBG, if called for in the tender can also be paid through Insura nce Surety Bonds' or 'account payee demand draft' or 'fixed deposit receipt from a Scheduled Commercial bank' or 'Bank Guarantee issued/ confirmed from an y Scheduled Commercial Banks in India' or online payment to be confirmed shar ing Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) to the tender inviting authority as called for in tender.
- 3.3 Bank Guarantees towards Bid Security/ Security Deposit/ PBG issued by Nationa lized Banks/ Scheduled Commercial Banks (other than Cooperative Banks) only acceptable.
- 3.4 EMD/ Bid Security may be adjusted towards SD. However, if EMD is submitted in the form of Bank Gu arantee, fresh Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format or demand draft/Bankers cheque is to be su bmitted towards SD.

3.5 The SD shall not bear any interest and is liable to be forfeited for unsatisfactory completion or on ab andonment of the supply/ work order.

# 4.0 Liquidated Damges for Delayed Execution of Contract:

If the Service Provider fails to perform the services within the time period(s) spe cified in the CONTRACT, the EMPLOYER shall, without prejudice to his other reme dies under the CONTRACT, levy Liquidated damages from the CONTRACT PRICE, a sum calculated on the basis of the CONTRACT PRICE, including subsequent mo difications.

## **Deductions shall apply as per following formula:**

Half percent (0.5%) of the contract value per week of delay subject to a maximu m of ten percent (10%) of contract value.

EMPLOYER may deduct the amount so payable by Service Provider, from any am ount falling due to the Service Provider or by recovery against the Performance Guarantee. Both Service Provider and EMPLOYER agree that the above percenta ges of price reduction are genuine pre-estimates of the loss/damage which the EMPLOYER would have suffered on account of delay/breach on the part of the Service Provider and the said amount will be payable on demand without there being any proof of the actual loss/or damage caused by such breach/delay. A decision of the EMPLOYER in the matter of applicability of price reduction shall be final and binding.

Delivery shall be completed within 60 days from the date of issue of purchase ord er.

#### **6.0 Payment Terms**

- b. All payments are subject to deduction of tax at source as applicable.
- c. GST Law mandates Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) vide Section 51 of the C GST/SGST Act 2017, Section 20 of the IGST Act, 2017and Section 21 of the U TGST Act, 2017.
- d. Our GSTIN33AAACI2799F1ZL and SAC code of service is to be mentioned in the bills.
