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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up

to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity \div Original quantity) \times Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Bidder should submit the below documents towards Pre-Qualification Criteria

1. The bidder shall be an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) of Sweeping Machine or their Authorized dealer. Authorized dealers/ agents are required to submit authorization letter from OEM.

2. OEM/Authorized Dealer of Sweeping Machine should have supplied at least one no. of similar item to an y Public/Private Industry during last three years ending April 2025.

3. Bidder shall submit copies of Purchase/Work orders for "diesel operated ride-on sweeper machine" supp lied by them with reputed parties during the last three years.

a) Three orders each costing not less than ₹18,14,000/- (incl. GST)

(or)

b) Two orders each costing not less than ₹22,67,500/- (incl. GST)

c) One order each costing not less than ₹36,28,000/-(incl. GST)

4. In proof of the above, the following documents are to be submitted along with offer.

a. Purchase order copy of similar supply in the name of OEM or authorized bidder.

b. Satisfactory performance certificate / work completion certificate from the client.

Definition of 'Similar Supply': Supply of 'Diesel operated Heavy Duty Ride-on Sweeper Machine' with min. r ated power of 47HP and Sweeping Area performance with one side broom of 19,000-20,000 m2 /hr @10-11 km/hr.

5. Average annual turnover of the tenderer during the last 3 years, ending 31st March, 2024 should be ₹13,60,500/- (incl. GST) (Documentary proof of the above should be enclosed). The tenderer shall submit cop y of P & L account / IT return / turnover certificate for the last three years.

Note:

1. In the absence of receipt of documents meeting to Pre-qualification criteria, the offer will not be conside red under any circumstances.

2. Relaxation in prior turnover and prior experience shall be given to MSEs / Start-ups (as defined by Depar tment of Industrial Policy and Promotion) as per Government Circular / Guidelines subject to meeting of qu ality and technical Specification.

3. The offers of the bidders who have defaulted in the past in execution of the contracts or in complying wi th the obligations as per the contract shall not be considered.

4. Traders/ distributors/ sole agent/ Works Contract are excluded from the purview of the Procurement Policy for Micro and small Enterprises, 2012 (as amended time to time).

2.0 The rate quoted shall be FOR IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi. The items have to be supplied strictly as per the technical specification within the delivery period mentioned in the tender.

3.0 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

3.1 ₹76,864/- (Rupees Seventy six thousand eight hundred and sixty four only)

3.2 Tenderer shall remit EMD through RTGS/ NEFT infavour of M/s IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi.

3.3 Tenderer shall inform details of remittance of EMD & TDC through E-Mail/ FAX. The E-mail should conta in full postal address of the Tenderer, Tender No. for which EMD & TDC were paid, payment details includin g amount, and UTR No. and bank details from which payment was done. 3.4 Incase tenderer is submitting BG in lieu of EMD the same shall be strictly in the format given in the ten der. The Original BG shall reach this office at least 3 days in advance from the date of opening of Techno-C ommercial Bid.

3.5 Offers without EMD or valid EMD exemption certificate shall not be considered.

3.6 The EMD is liable to be forfeited if:

i. The tenderer changes the terms and conditions or prices or withdraw his quotation subsequent to the dat e of opening.

ii. The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence supplies/works after accepting t he order.

iii. In case bidder submits false/fabricated documents.

iv. In case bidder fails to submit SD within 30 days of receipt of work/supply order.

3.7 PSU, State Govt. Undertakings are exempted from payment of EMD subject to request and approval. M SME /SSI units are exempted from payment of EMD/ TDC provided they submit valid MSME/ NSIC certific ate along with commercial bid and to ensure that certificate pertains to the class of item/works for which fl oated.

4.0 Security Deposit (SD) (For supply orders above ₹ 5 Lakhs)

The successful tenderer has to submit Security Deposit @5% of the contract value in the form of RTGS/NE FT/ BG within 21 days of receipt of our PO as security for satisfactory completion of the order. The SD shall not bear any interest and is liable to be forfeited for unsatisfactory completion or on abandonment of the s upply order. The EMD can be adjusted towards Security Deposit. However, if EMD is submitted in the form of BG, fresh BG is to be submitted towards SD in the prescribed format as per tender. If the Supplier fails t o provide the security deposit within the period specified, such failure shall constitute a breach of the Cont ract and IREL shall be entitled to make other arrangements for the repurchase of the stores contracted for at the risk and expense of the supplier and/or to recover from the supplier the damages arising from such c ancellation.

5.0 Pre-delivery inspection and testing:

Supplier shall arrange for a pre-delivery inspection of the equipment at their works before dispatch. On rec eipt of intimation from the supplier about their readiness, IREL shall carryout the pre-delivery inspection at Supplier's place and conduct test work and issue clearance for dispatch. However the final inspection on r eccept of the equipment at IREL MK shall be the basis of acceptance of the equipment by IREL. 6.0 Installation and Commissioning:

Successful bidder has to do installation, commissioning and demonstration of the equipment at our MK pla nt and necessary on site support and training to be given to the operators for the safe operation of machin e.

7.0 Payment terms:

90% payment along with 100% taxes and duties shall be made towards supply against tax invoice within 3 0 days of receipt & acceptance of the equipment at IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi Stores.

Balance 10% shall be paid 12 month after successful operation of the equipment or 18 months from date o f supply whichever is earlier.

Alternatively, the balance 10% will be paid on submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) by the Su pplier for 12 months from the date commissioning OR 18 months from the date of supply whichever is earli er. The PBG should have an additional claim period of 3 months.

Security deposit will be released on receipt & acceptance of the equipment at IREL (India) Limited, MK Stor es. The party has to quote term of price FOR MK unit, Manavalakurichi, Kanyakumari District, TamilNadu.

All the payments are subject to deduction of tax at source as applicable.

Payment will be done within 30 days after submitting the proper bill.

GST Law mandates Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) vide Section 51 of the CGST/SGST Act 2017, Section 20 of the IGST Act, 2017 and Section 21 of the UTGST Act, 2017.

All payments shall be done only through E-payment. Hence successful bidder has to provide Company na me, Account number, Name of the bank, nature of account (Savings/ Current/ CC/OD), IFS Code, Branch Co de along with invoice.

8.0 Time period of supply:

The delivery schedule shall be 60 days from the date of acceptance of the P.O.

9.0 Warranty:

The materials/equipment and all accessories supplied shall be warranted against any defective material, malfunctioning or poor workmanship for a minimum period of 12 months from the date of commissioning/ i nstallation or 18 months from the date of acceptance of supply, whichever is earlier.

11.0 Liquidated Damages

Subject to Article -25, if the SELLER fails to deliver any or all of the GOODS or performance the services wit hin the time period (s) specified in the CONTRACT, the PURCHASER shall, without prejudice to his other re medies under the CONTRACT, deduct from the CONTRACT PRICE, a sum calculated on the basis of the CON TRACT PRICE, including subsequent modifications.

Deductions shall apply as per following formula

A sum equivalent to 0.5 (Half) per cent of the prices of any portion of stores delivered late, for each week o r part thereof of delay. The total damages shall not exceed 10 (Ten) per cent of the value of delayed goods . The LD cannot exceed the amount stipulated in the contract.

In case of delay in delivery on the part of SELLER, the invoice/document value shall be reduced proportion ately for the delay and payment shall be released accordingly.

In the event the invoice value is not reduced proportionately for the delay, the PURCHASER may deduct the amount so payable by SELLER, from any amount falling due to the SELLER or by recovery against the Performance Guarantee. Both seller and PURCHASER agree that the above percentages of price reduction are genuine preestimates of the loss/damage which the PURCHASER would have suffered on account of del ay/breach on the part of the SELLER and the said amount will be payable on demand without there being a ny proof of the actual loss/or damage caused by such breach/delay. A decision of the PURCHASER in the m atter of applicability of price reduction shall be final and binding.

12.0 In case of any discrepancy between Gem ATC and Buyer ATC, terms stipulated in Buyer ATC shall go

vern.

13.0 In case of any discrepancy between GeM SLA terms and ATC stipulated by IREL, Terms stipulated by I REL shall govern.

14.0 MSE bidders are to carefully indicate their MSE status while bidding. In case any mistake done by the bidder, evaluation and order shall be done as per GeM provisions only and IREL (India) Limited shall not be anyway held responsible.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
