- b. Parties who have defaulted in execution of contracts in previous instances at IREL (India) Limited, OSCOM shall not be considered.
- c. IREL (India) Limited reserves the right of division of the works/Bill of Quantity among various tenderers to the advantages of IREL. The tenderers on their part shall accept such part (split) offered by IREL (India) Limited. The splitting of the quantity amongst more than one tenderer can be in the ratio of 60:40 at the rate offered by the overall lowest bidder.
