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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.

2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 4. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 5. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

6. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

7. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. 8. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

9. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 50% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity \div Original quantity) \times Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The tenderer should submit the following towards Pre- Qualification Criteria.

- 1. The bidder shall be an OEM or their authorized dealers/ distributors of following makes. *IPA*, *Newton weighing system*, *Avery*, *Precia Molen*. In case of dealers/distributors, a valid authori zation certificate/authorization letter from the OEM shall be submitted.
- 2. The bidder shall submit copies of similar orders executed by them with reputed parties during the last 7 years ending on 31.05.2025. (Similar order means supply, installation and commissioning of load cell based electronic belt weighers in industrial scale)

- 2. Relaxation in prior turnover and prior experience shall be given to MSEs / Start-ups (as defined by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) as per Government Circular / Guidelines subject to meeting of quality and technical Specification.
- 3. The offers of the bidders who have defaulted in the past in execution of the contracts or in c omplying with the obligations as per the contract shall not be considered.

- 2.0 The rate quoted shall be FOR IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi. The items have to be su pplied strictly as per the technical specification within the delivery period mentioned in the t ender.
- 3.0 Delivery Period: All materials under scope of supply for the belt weighers shall be supplied a nd installation & commissioning shall be done within 60 days from the date of receipt of ord er.

4.0—Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- 4.1—Tenderer shall remit EMD through RTGS/ NEFT infavour of M/s IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi.
- 4.2.—Tenderer shall inform details of remittance of EMD & TDC through E-Mail/ FAX. The E-mail should contain full postal address of the Tenderer, Tender No. for which EMD & TDC were paid, payment details including amount, and UTR No. and bank details from which payment was d one. - 4.3.—Incase tenderer is submitting BG in lieu of EMD the same shall be strictly in the format given in the tender. The Original BG shall reach this office at least 3 days in advance from the date of opening of Techno-Commercial Bid.
- 4.4.—Offers without EMD or valid EMD exemption certificate shall not be considered.
- 4.5.—The EMD is liable to be forfeited if:
 - ——i.-The tenderer changes the terms and conditions or prices or withdraw his quotation subs equent to the date of opening.
 - ——ii.—The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence supplies/works after accepting the order.
- 4.6.—PSU, State Govt. Undertakings are exempted from payment of EMD subject to request and a

pproval. MSME /SSI units are exempted from payment of **EMD/ TDC** provided they submitvalid MSME/ NSIC certificate along with commercial bid and to ensure that certificate pertain s to the class of item/works for which floated.

4.7 Traders/ distributors/ sole agent/ Works Contract are excluded from the purview of the Procurement Policy for Micro and small Enterprises, 2012 (as amended time to time).

5.0 Security Deposit (SD) (For supply orders above ₹ 5 Lakhs)

The successful tenderer has to submit Security Deposit **@5% of the contract value** in the form of RTGS/NEFT/ BG within 21 days of receipt of our PO as security for satisfactory comp letion of the order. The SD shall not bear any interest and is liable to be forfeited for unsatisf actory completion or on abandonment of the supply order. The EMD can be adjusted toward s Security Deposit. However, if EMD is submitted in the form of BG, fresh BG is to be submit ted towards SD in the prescribed format as per tender. If the Supplier fails to provide the se curity deposit within the period specified, such failure shall constitute a breach of the Contract and IREL shall be entitled to make other arrangements for the repurchase of the st ores contracted for at the risk and expense of the supplier and/or to recover from the supplie er the damages arising from such cancellation.

6.0 Payment terms

90% payment shall be made after satisfactory completion of supply, installation and commi ssioning of belt weighers. Remaining 10% will be released after completion of warranty/perf ormance guarantee period.

Our standard payment term is 100% payment within 30 days from the date of receipt and a cceptance of materials along with all relevant documents" **NO advance payment shall b e made under any circumstances**. Interest @ 12% shall be considered for evaluation of bids in case of supplier(s)/contractor(s) requesting for payment earlier than our stipulated t erms.

7.0 Liquidated Damages

Subject to Article -25, if the SELLER fails to deliver any or all of the GOODS or performance t he services within the time period (s) specified in the CONTRACT, the PURCHASER shall, with out prejudice to his other remedies under the CONTRACT, deduct from the CONTRACT PRICE, a sum calculated on the basis of the CONTRACT PRICE, including subsequent modifications.

Deductions shall apply as per following formula

A sum equivalent to 0.5 (Half) per cent of the prices of any portion of stores delivered late, f or each week or part thereof of delay. The total damages shall not exceed 10 (Ten) per cent of the value of delayed goods. The LD cannot exceed the amount stipulated in the contract.

In case of delay in delivery on the part of SELLER, the invoice/document value shall be reduc ed proportionately for the delay and payment shall be released accordingly.

In the event the invoice value is not reduced proportionately for the delay, the PURCHASER may deduct the amount so payable by SELLER, from any amount falling due to the SELLER or by recovery against the Performance Guarantee. Both seller and PURCHASER agree that the above percentages of price reduction are genuine pre estimates of the loss/damage which th e PURCHASER would have suffered on account of delay/breach on the part of the SELLER and the said amount will be payable on demand without there being any proof of the actual los s/or damage caused by such breach/delay. A decision of the PURCHASER in the matter of ap plicability of price reduction shall be final and binding.

In case of any discrepancy between GeM GTC and Buyer ATC, terms stipulated under buyer

ATC shall govern.

8.0 Penalty for delay in breakdown execution: Failure to attend the breakdown withi n the time specified in the PO shall attract a penalty of Rs.500 per day, which sha II be deducted from the next AMC invoice.

- **9.0 Warranty**: The Load cell based belt weighers supplied should be warranted for a period of 1 2 months from the date of commissioning for any manufacturing defects, faulty workmanshi p and defective materials.
- **10.0** Performance Guarantee: The guarantee for the performance of the system should be furnish ed by way of bank guarantee from a nationalized bank for an amount of 10% of the total val ue valid for a period of 12 months.

11.0 Total value of Annual maintenance contract for 8 visit after the warranty period (Quarterly o nce as per the schedule) (including taxes, if any) must mentioned separately and uploaded a long with Price bid. The value of Annual maintenance contract(AMC) for one year shall not beyond 10% of the Total value of the "SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF BELT WEIGHER as per scope of supply and technical specification (excluding Annual maintenance contract value)".

- **a.** The price shall be firm throughout the Annual maintenance Contract Period.
- b. A separate work order will be issued to the L1 bidder after completion of warranty period for execution of Annual Maintenance contract for the weigher.
- **12.0** A price schedule for the **recommended spares** shall be submitted along with the price bid. The price shall be firm throughout the contract period and Annual maintenance Contract Peri od.
- **13.0** In case of any discrepancy between Gem ATC and Buyer ATC, terms stipulated in Buyer AT C shall govern.
- **14.0** In case of any discrepancy between GeM SLA terms and ATC stipulated by IREL, Terms stip ulated by IREL shall govern.
- 15.0 MSE bidders are to carefully indicate their MSE status while bidding. In case any mistake done by the bidder, evaluation and order shall be done as per GeM provi sions only and IREL (India) Limited shall not be anyway held responsible.

- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
