8. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. Pre- Qualification Criteria for Supply of Laboratory rare Earth Drum magnetic Separator-REDMS

A. Technical

(i) The bidder shall be OEM or authorized distributor. OEM shall submit self-declaration and authorized distributor shall submit copy of valid authorization certificate.

AND

(ii) The Bidder should have supplied at least 1 No. of REDMS of Dimension 15" Dia x 12" wide or higher to any beach sand mineral processing Industry which processes minerals like Ilmenite Rutile, Zircon, Monazite, Garnet & Sillimanite in last Seven Years ending on March 2024. To verify the same, the bidder shall submit the following.

- a) Copies of purchase order/s & completion/performance certificate, And
- b) Manufacturer Certificate/Declaration that the Rare Earth magnets installed in the equipment are of Neodymium - Iron - Boron type

B. Financial

(i) Average Annual Financial Turnover of the bidder during the last three consecutive financial years ending on March 2023 shall be minimum Rs.5.00 Lakhs. In case the date of constitution/incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

To verify the same, the bidder shall submit copies of audited P&L statements/26AS/GST Returns for the relevant period.

OR

(ii) Bidder shall be registered with GST. To verify the same, copy of GST Registration Certificate shall be submitted.

Bids meeting PQ-A (i) & (ii) and PQ-B (i) or (ii) only will be considered for further processing subject to meeting technical and commercial conditions/requirements specified in the tender.

6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
