TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION FOR PRELAMINATED HDPE BAGS WITH LDPE INNER

1. GENERAL

- The supplier shall manufacture and supply HDPE bags for packing of Tri-Sodium Phosphate strictly conforming to the following specifications.
- The bags to be supplied shall be of HDPE fabric woven in circular looms (having notwisting of WEFT) with inside lamination by way of inverting the cylinder of fabric after it is laminat ed. The bags shall be without any side seam.
- · 'L' stitched bags made of circular woven HDPE fabric shall not be accepted.

2. SIZE & CAPACITY

Length and width both should not be short simultaneously. The dimensions of bags shall be within above mentioned tolerance and within specified limit of minimum inside area as per BIS.

3. FABRIC

- The fabric shall be woven from HDPE tapes conforming to IS 6192 (Latest) and shall befree from all major weaving defects like pick points, missing tapes etc. and it shall be free from biasness also.
- The construction of the HDPE fabric shall be as per the specifications given below.
- The bag shall be made from single piece of laminated HDPE woven fabric. The appearance of bag shall be Milky white with Blue tone. Required quantity of correct quality of Master Bat ch should be used.

4. LAMINATION

- The bags shall be inside laminated with direct application of minimum **100 gauge** of virgin quality low density polyethylene (LDPE) film in a lamination plant. The lamination shall be fr ee from Pinholes, Porosity, Tears, Patches, Air pockets, Blisters or any other visible defects.
- The thickness of the lamination shall be minimum 100 gauge (25 micron) with a tolerance of + 10%, **No negative tolerance is acceptable.**
- The lamination shall cover the entire inner area of the fabric used in the bag.
- The fabric shall be laminated on both the layer of fabrics and then shall be inverted. While I aminating minimum overlap of 10 mm shall be provided on the edge of lamination.
- · The suppliers before dispatching the laminated bags should ensure the quality of laminatio

- n. Any lamination failure at IREL site, during sample testing or during use of bags if noticed, the entire lot of bags shall be rejected and unused bags shall be rejected & supplier shall re place equal quantity of rejected bags at free of cost.
- During lamination of HDPE fabric, required quantity of Master batch shall be used to give M ilky white with Blue tone appearance to Bag.

5. STITCHING

- The bottom of the bag shall have minimum 25 mm folding when measured from outside.
- The bottom of the bags shall have one fold (4 layers).
- The bag shall be stitched at the bottom with two rows of chain stitches. The materials used for stitching shall be HDPE tape having at least 20 percent higher denier than that used for making the sack. The stitching shall be uniform without any loose thread or knot.
- The distance between the rows shall be minimum 5 mm. The outer row shall be minimum 8 mm from the outer edge of the bottom of the bag.
- The bag is to be stitched on both bottom corner edges of the bag diagonally 150 mm from the bottom corners (the distance of the stitch is to be 150 mm in the length and width direction). This is required for lifting of the bags manually.

6. <u>Important Note:</u>

- The liner length used in folding / stitching portion is not taken into account by us while working out above mentioned size of liner.
- Thickness of liner: 250 gauge ± 10%
- Liner should be heat sealed at the bottom and should be stitched with HDPE fabric from 1" from the heat seal. It means after heat sealing the liner, the remaining liner should be stitched maximum 1" from the heat sealed strips.

7. STRENGTH:

Test procedure and details for branding shall be as follows: The HDPE bag branding testing has bee n indicated above. IREL recommends that the supplier should test the quality of branding as per the procedure narrated below, prior to dispatch of the lot.

11. TESTING PROCEDURE
