IREL will submit their comments on the Draft TEFR (point 1) and Draft DPR (Point 4) of “Time Lines” within a period of 15 days of submissions. However, if there is any delay on part of IREL in submitting their comments on draft reports or written intimation to successful bidder in case of DPR preparation, the duration of contract will be extended suitably.	The contract shall take effect from 15 days of acceptance of the Work Order/ LOI and shall remain in force for a period of 20(twenty) months unless terminated or extended in accordance with the terms of Agreed terms. Whether the DPR shall also be for a capacity of 2500 Tonnes RE Oxalate / year ?.	<p>No. TEFR to be prepared for a tentative production of 2500 tons RE Oxalate product per annum from the operations of mining, pre-concentration and RE Oxalate extraction in the project. (Please refer SCOC Phase-I)</p> <p>Based on the performance/outcome of the final TEFR, DPR shall be prepared by the Consultant after receipt of confirmation from IREL. The production capacity of RE Oxalate / year for DPR shall be as per IREL directives. Hence the RE Oxalate production capacity for DPR may vary from 2500 TPA.(Please refer SCOC , Phase-II)</p>
2	Project site is yet to be selected by IREL. Consultant is to recommend suitable site in the vicinity of Mine. Who will arrange inputs for the project from various authorities during the preparation of TEFR/DPR ?	<p>Ambadongar RE Project is a Green field project. Field survey work is not required at site during preparation of TEFR/ DPR. IREL is having the Geological report and the bench scale metallurgical test reports of the proposed project. The geological report of the Deposit provides the Geographical coordinates of the mineral bearing area.</p> <p>The successful bidder has to arrange and prepare the cadastral plans or surface maps from appropriate records in a proper scale towards locating & demarcating the project units / operations and propose suitable sites for locating project units/operations. The successful bidder shall provide the land use and land classification details for the project area and assess any restrictions in the proposed project areas. IREL will extend the necessary support as and when required by the successful bidder.</p>
3	Whether the successful bidder is required to carry out R&R Studies? If yes, then whether this is required during the TEFR stage or DPR Stage?	<p>Please refer SCOC. In case, the successful bidder proposes the land for mining lease area, sites for Pre-Con Plant, RE Oxalate Plant and other auxiliary units requires any land acquisition and/or requires any involuntary displacement of persons from that area then R & R reports are to be provided.</p> <p>In case of requirement of R & R for the integrated project as it influences the economic viability of the integrated project, the successful bidder shall address the R & R details in brief along with cost implications in TEFR.</p> <p>The detailed R & R studies / reports are required in case the Land Acquisition and/or involuntary displacement of persons from the area during the preparation of the DPR.</p>
